

To Whom It May Concern:

We have been informed by NSW Health and Multicultural NSW that the production of video content for church services is permissible under the following conditions:

- 1. The Public Health (COVID-19 Restrictions on Gathering and Movement) Order 2020 legislates the application of the two-person public gathering rule in NSW, and that people must not leave their place of residence without reasonable excuse.
- 2. A person may leave their premises for the purpose of work where it isn't possible to work from home. This applies to work done as a volunteer or for a charitable organisation, and where a person is providing assistance to a vulnerable person or an emergency service.
- 3. Places of worship must not be open to members of the public, except for the purposes of conducting small weddings of up to 5 people and funerals of up to 10 people.
- 4. This does not prevent the streaming or broadcasting of religious services in places of worship, as long as these services are closed to the public.
- 5. The number of people participating in the streaming or broadcasting of religious services should be kept to a minimum, as essential to the religious service.
- 6. The Order also does not prevent the use of premises to provide a service to assist vulnerable members of the public, such as a foodbank.
- 7. The occupier or operator of the premises must ensure there is 4 square metres of space for each person on the premises and social distancing should be practiced.
