KEY REQUIREMENTS:

Have a can-do attitude and a be on time for set up.

CHARACTER:

- Value and be growing in a relationship with Jesus
- Have others around you in your walk with Christ who affirm your character (staff, small group leader, team leader references)
- Have integrity to 'be the same person in every room'

CONVICTION:

- Be actively engaged in the life of St Paul's church, through regularly attending a service and small group (at least 6 months prior)
- Agree with SPCH Vision, Mission & Statement of Beliefs (https://stpauls.church/what-we-believe/)
- An understanding of our Vital Signs

COMPETENCY:

• An ability to set up and pack up tables/tea and coffee equipment, etc

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBLITIES:

Arrive and hour beforehand, set up anything needed (other than tech) for the event and pack it up afterwards neatly to be accessed again easily by other teams.

TRAINING AND SUPPORT:

Patrick or another staff member will be onsite when you arrive to give instructions and directions on what needs to be done, where things can be found, and how to set it all up.
