YOUNG ADULT SMALL GROUP LEADER

Our St Paul's mission is to bring people to Christ, build them in Christ, and send them out for Christ.

VISION/GOAL FOR THIS ROLE: Young Adult small group leaders will be responsible for the discipleship and development of young people as they grow in their faith; guiding them through the Word and through the turbulent time of life that they are in.

TIME COMMITMENT: The time commitment for this role has some freedom to it and is somewhat at your discretion, however, as a minimum it should be no less than once a week during the school term with freedom to break or keep going over the school holidays as you see fit.

KEY REQUIREMENTS:

You must have a current Safe Ministry certificate and stay up to date with a refresher course every 3 years.

CHARACTER:

- Value and be growing in a relationship with Jesus
- Live a personal life that is above reproach
- Have others around you in your walk with Christ who affirm your character (staff, small group leader, team leader references)
- Have integrity to 'be the same person in every room'

CONVICTION:

- Be actively engaged in the life of St Paul's church, through regularly attending a service and small group (at least 6 months prior)
- Agree with SPCH Vision, Mission & Statement of Beliefs (https://stpauls.church/what-we-believe/)
- An understanding of our Vital Signs

COMPETENCY:

- · An ability to facilitate a discussion group that promotes conversation and growth
- An ability to be comfortable in not knowing all the answers and being honest with that
- An ability to then go and research and find answers to the questions you are unsure of or be able to point people in the right direction (books, commentaries, etc.)
- An ability to engage pastorally with your small group members

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBLITIES:

- Prepare a study each week for your small group to go through
 - o If you are following the church series, then go through them beforehand and edit them as you see fit for those in your group
 - o If doing your own studies, you must prepare them yourself.
- Attend weekly small group at a regularly set time and location
 - o That location does not have to be supplied by you, it can be another group members place, a public place, or even at church. If it is at church, please contact Patrick Jones to organise a time and a room available
- Attend all young adult small group events as a group, this can either be on top of your weekly commitment or in place of.
- Communicate any information regarding to your group or about these events via a group chat of your choosing (messenger or WhatsApp seem to be easiest).
