KEY REQUIREMENTS:

You must have a current Safe Ministry certificate, and stay up-to-date with a refresher course every 3 years.

CHARACTER:

- Value and be growing in a relationship with Jesus
- Live a personal life that is above reproach
- Have others around you in your walk with Christ who affirm your character (staff, small group leader, team leader references)

CONVICTION:

- Be actively engaged in the life of St Paul's church, through regularly attending a service and small group (at least 6 months prior)
- Agree with SPCH Vision, Mission & Statement of Beliefs (<https://stpauls.church/what-we-believe/>)
- An understanding of our Vital Signs

COMPETENCY:

- An ability to research topics, both secular and theological
- An ability to explain an explore Bible passages in a clear manner
- An ability to work in a team effectively and efficiently, being a decision maker, and completing all tasks required of you.

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Researching content for the podcast episodes, teaching nights, and the big weekend
- Finding speakers and developing content for teaching sessions on teaching nights and for the sessions involved at the big weekend event.
- Working with the rest of the teaching team together to organise the content for these events.

TRAINING AND SUPPORT:

- You will be supported by Patrick Jones and the rest of your team receiving training in how to research and come up with the content during the teaching team meetings before events.
