Our St Paul's mission is to bring people to Christ, build them in Christ, and send them out for Christ.

VISION/GOAL FOR THIS ROLE: Kids Connect Leaders help run the KC program in having kids connect with other kids, parents connect with each other and the church connect with the community. We seek to show Christ's love to those in a tough season of life and to share the Gospel and grow personal connections.

TIME COMMITMENT: Tuesdays and/or Thursdays in public school term times from between 9:30-12:00. (Program runs 10:00-11:30) Training once a year and meetings termly.

KEY REQUIREMENTS:

You must hold a current WWCC#, which you should provide to our administration team along with your date of birth for verification.

You must have a current Safe Ministry certificate, and stay up-to-date with a refresher course every 3 years.

CHARACTER:

- Value and be growing in a relationship with Jesus
- Live a personal life that is above reproach
- Have others around you in your walk with Christ who affirm your character (staff, small group leader, team leader references)

CONVICTION:

- Be actively engaged in the life of St Paul's church, through regularly attending a service and small group (at least 6 months prior)
- Agree with SPCH Vision, Mission & Statement of Beliefs (<https://stpauls.church/what-we-believe/>)
- An understanding of our Vital Signs

COMPETENCY:

- *Able to support the team in maintaining a clean and welcoming environment*
- *Personable, welcoming and set culture of kindness within the group*
- *Able to teach simple bible lessons or support those that do*

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

These roles can vary depending who is on the team and are often shared/distributed between SPCH mums.

Set up from 9:30 and pack from 11:30

Instructions and training available

Making sure sign in/welcome for all parents especially new

Participate in What's app group for general admin

Be able to meet and pray over the people and ministry with wider team as organised by Naomi and support each other in this season of ministry

TRAINING AND SUPPORT:

We will advise for attendance if pertinent at Kids Team training dinners (maybe once a year)

On the job training will be with Naomi and/or current team members

We communicate with others, chat with peers and ask questions on both fb and what's app depending on day

Naomi will organise keys if this is necessary for you or whether other members on team will do this.

Meeting once term will also be a chance to check in for review and planning for each individual as they lead.
