VISION/GOAL FOR THIS ROLE: The purpose of our Children's Ministry is to lead children across SPCH in accordance with our strategy of Bring, Build, & Send so that they are transformed into age-appropriate disciples of Jesus.

Provide quality sound and visuals to support the word ministry to children in our parish.

TIME COMMITMENT: Rostered (every $2^{nd}/3^{rd}$ week). 9.30-11.30am, plus time during the week to view PCO to plan for what's ahead (10 mins).

KEY REQUIREMENTS:

You must

- Hold a current wwcc (volunteer or employed)
- Complete a SMC (Safe Ministry Check).
- Complete Safe Ministry Course (completed online and refreshed every 3 years).
- Agree to sign on for a year minimum.

CHARACTER:

- Value and be growing in a relationship with Jesus
- Be punctual & prepared for Kids Alive
- Be faithful in serving as part of a team.

CONVICTION:

- Be actively engaged in the life of St Paul's church, through regularly attending a service and small group (at least 6 months prior)
- Agree with SPCH Vision, Mission & Statement of Beliefs (https://stpauls.church/what-we-believe/)

COMPETENCY:

- I will use my gifts and talents that God has given to me for His glory.
- I will be thankful and praise God in all things, big and small.
- I will not settle for mediocrity.

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBLITIES:

- Arrive at 9.30am to MEET in the CEC room 3 to prepare and set up.
- Be warm and WELCOMING to all children who come to the program.
- Turn equipment on.
- Set up microphones
- Set up playlists and Pro presenter following the PCO order of service.
- Turn on projectors.
- Trouble shoot any problems.
- Enable the 2 children's services to flow smoothly through technology support.

Preparing

- Please review Planning Centre Office (PCO) before coming so that you will know what the morning will look like.
- Be trained under a current leader before serving alone.

TRAINING AND SUPPORT:

 You will be provided with a tech leader who will give you support and direction. On the job training. This informal learning will happen naturally in your rostered week.
