VISION/GOAL FOR THIS ROLE:

121 Partnerships are about getting into God's word in a relaxed and relational setting. The 'Driver' might meet with another person of similar spiritual maturity ('iron sharpens iron'), or someone younger in the faith ('wilderness guide'), or someone at the beginning of their walk with Jesus ('lets start walking'). Partnerships last for up to 12 months and then usually multiply

TIME COMMITMENT:

Flexible - regular 121 bible reading meetings of between 30-60 minutes, weekly or fortnightly, for a fixed time period of 3 or 6 or 12 months

KEY REQUIREMENTS:

You must be a committed member of St Paul's

CHARACTER:

- Value and be growing in a relationship with Jesus
- Live a personal life that is above reproach
- Have others around you in your walk with Christ who affirm your character (staff, small group leader, team leader references)
- Have integrity to 'be the same person in every room'

CONVICTION:

- Be actively engaged in the life of St Paul's church, at least through regularly attending a service
- Agree with SPCH Vision, Mission & Statement of Beliefs (<https://stpauls.church/what-we-believe/>)
- An understanding of our Vital Signs

COMPETENCY:

- An ability to have develop a relationship through conversation
- A more than basic understanding of the Bible and how to read it
- An ability to organise regular meetings

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Organise regular catch ups and follow through
- Steer an organised time together - social catchup, opening the bible, praying through bible application for life
- Prepare and communicate what you will read together - follow up on any questions that might arise
