ROLE TITLE: Prayer Network Volunteers

Our St Paul's mission is to bring people to Christ, build them in Christ, and send them out for Christ.

VISION/GOAL FOR THIS ROLE: The Prayer Network is a vital part of our church's ministry, where individuals commit to regularly praying for the needs of our congregation, ministries, and the wider community. By joining this network, you become a key part of the spiritual backbone of St Paul's, lifting up prayer requests and interceding for God's will to be done in our church and beyond.

Each month, a prayer email is sent with updated prayer points, and Prayer Network members dedicate time to pray through those requests, offering support and bringing the needs of others before God.

TIME COMMITMENT:

- **Monthly Prayer Email:** Receive and pray through the prayer points shared via email
- **Prayer Time:** Pray as you are able, committing to regular prayer for the church, its ministries and its members
- **Flexibility:** You can pray on your own schedule; there is no specific time requirement beyond reading the prayer email and committing to pray

KEY REQUIREMENTS:

There are no diocese/legal requirements.

- **Character:**
 - Value and be growing in a relationship with Jesus
 - Have a heart for seeking God and trusting Him in prayer
 - Live a personal life that is above reproach
- **Conviction:**
 - Desire to see prayer as central to the life of the church
 - Be actively engaged in the life of St Paul's church, through regularly attending a service and small group (at least 6 months prior)
 - Agree with SPCH Vision, Mission & Statement of Beliefs (<https://stpauls.church/what-we-believe/>)

- **Competency:**
 - Willingness to commit time to pray for others regularly
 - No special prayer skills needed — just a heart to support through prayer

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Receive monthly prayer emails with updated prayer points
- Commit time to pray for the listed requests on a regular basis
- Pray for the needs of the church, ministries, leaders, and individuals in the congregation

TRAINING AND SUPPORT:

While no formal training is required, you will receive monthly prayer points, and regular communication will be sent to encourage and support your participation in the Prayer Network.
