

### St Paul's Castle Hill Volunteer Job Description

**ROLE TITLE:** Christianity Explained Leader

Our St Paul's mission is to bring people to Christ, build them in Christ, and send them out for Christ.

**STAFF MINISTRY LEADER:** Bruce Stanley (Senior Minister)

**VISION/GOAL FOR THIS ROLE:** Christianity Explained is a six-session evangelistic course designed for individuals with little or no Christian background. The course covers:

- 1. Jesus [Son of God]: Jesus' authority as the Son of God, His teachings, and miracles.
- 2. **Jesus [His Death]**: The significance of Jesus' death on the cross.
- 3. **Jesus [His Resurrection]**: The importance of Jesus' resurrection.
- 4. God's Gift: Salvation as a free gift of grace.
- 5. **Repenting**: Understanding repentance and turning to God.
- 6. **Believing**: Embracing faith in Jesus and the Christian life.

As a Christianity Explained Leader, you will facilitate this course, guiding participants through each session, fostering discussion, and helping them explore the core messages of Christianity.

### TIME COMMITMENT:

- Course Duration: 6 sessions (typically held weekly or bi-weekly)
- Session Duration: Approximately 90 minutes per session
- Preparation Time: 1–2 hours per session for review and planning

#### **KEY REQUIREMENTS:**

There are no diocese/legal requirements.

# • Character:

- Value and be growing in a relationship with Jesus
- Live a personal life that is above reproach

#### • Conviction:

- Be actively engaged in the life of St Paul's church, through regularly attending a service and small group (at least 6 months prior)
- Agree with SPCH Vision, Mission & Statement of Beliefs (<a href="https://stpauls.church/what-we-believe/">https://stpauls.church/what-we-believe/</a>)

#### Competency:

- Comfortable leading small group discussions and facilitating conversations
- Able to communicate clearly and effectively, especially with individuals new to Christianity
- O Demonstrate patience, empathy, and a non-judgmental attitude
- o Experience in leading or facilitating groups is beneficial but not required

#### **KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBLITIES**

- Lead and facilitate the six-session Christianity Explained course
- Guide participants through the course materials, ensuring clarity and understanding
- Foster an open and welcoming environment for questions and discussions
- Pray with and for participants, supporting their spiritual journey
- Encourage participants to take next steps in their faith journey, such as joining a small group and attending church services
- Collaborate with other leaders and staff to ensure the course runs smoothly
- Provide feedback and suggestions for improving the course experience

# **TRAINING AND SUPPORT:**

You will receive training on the course materials and facilitation techniques. Ongoing support will be provided through regular check-ins with ministry leaders and access to additional resources as needed.
