ROLE TITLE: Family Fun Fair Entertainers

Our St Paul's mission is to bring people to Christ, build them in Christ, and send them out for Christ.

VISION/GOAL FOR THIS ROLE: The Family Fun Fair is a vibrant and joyful part of our Kids Ministry events at St Paul's, run approximately four times a year as part of events like Easter Camp, Big Play Out, Christmas Eve services, etc. These events are designed to welcome families, build community, and create positive experiences of church for children and their caregivers.

The Family Fun Fair Entertainers help bring the fun to life! Whether it's through face painting, balloon twisting, puppetry, simple magic shows, or other child-friendly skills, this team plays a key role in creating a warm and engaging environment that reflects the love and joy of Christ.

TIME COMMITMENT:

This is a casual, flexible role and Family Fun Fair events come up approximately four times a year. You'll be notified and rostered ahead of time subject to your availability, and given full event details. On event days, team members should arrive 30 minutes before the scheduled start time to help set up and prepare the space. Event duration will likely be 2 - 3 hours.

KEY REQUIREMENTS:

There are no formal diocese/legal requirements, but a Working With Children Check may be required depending on the role and nature of the event. This will be confirmed and supported by staff as needed.

- Character:
 - Value and be growing in a relationship with Jesus
 - Live a personal life that is above reproach
- Conviction:
 - Be actively engaged in the life of St Paul's church, through regularly attending a service and small group (at least 6 months prior)
 - Agree with SPCH Vision, Mission & Statement of Beliefs (<u>https://stpauls.church/what-we-believe/</u>)
- Competency:
 - Enjoy engaging with children in a playful, friendly, and safe manner

- Willingness to learn a new skill (e.g., face painting or balloon twisting) if not already trained
- Comfortable performing or interacting with groups of kids in a public setting
- Reliability and flexibility during fast-moving, high-energy events

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBLITIES

- Arrive 30 minutes before the start of the Family Fun Fair to set up your activity or station
- Serve as an entertainer during the event—this may include:
 - Face painting
 - Balloon animal creation
 - Puppetry or simple skits
 - Children's magic tricks
 - Other kid-friendly talents that bring joy!
- Engage children and families warmly and appropriately throughout your station
- Assist with packing down your area and helping the team clean up after the event.

TRAINING AND SUPPORT:

Don't worry if you don't have experience—we'll provide training, templates, supplies, and support to help you grow in your role. You'll be part of a fun, encouraging team that shares a passion for kids and the gospel. Staff and team leaders will guide you on best practices for safety, communication, and performance.
