VISION/GOAL FOR THIS ROLE: To enhance the Crossfire youth experience by providing and operating audiovisual equipment throughout the night, fostering an immersive worship environment, and supporting sermon delivery.

TIME COMMITMENT:

Every school term Friday nights: 5:00 PM to 10:30 PM

KEY REQUIREMENTS:

You must hold a current WWCC#, which you should provide to our administration team along with your date of birth for verification.

You must have a current Safe Ministry certificate and stay up-to-date with a refresher course every 3 years.

CHARACTER:

- Willing to learn.
- Part of a team (Collaborative teamwork).
- Passion to use technical skills to enhance worship and sermons.
- Value and be growing in a relationship with Jesus.
- Live a personal life that is above reproach.

CONVICTION:

- Be actively engaged in the life of St Paul's church, through regularly attending a service and small group (at least 6 months prior)
- Agree with SPCH Vision, Mission & Statement of Beliefs (<u>https://stpauls.church/what-we-believe/</u>)

COMPETENCY:

No technical skills required but an eagerness to learn audio-visual equipment.

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBLITIES:

- Arrive by 5:00 PM to start setup.
- Set up audio-visual equipment including microphones, speakers, projectors, and screens.
- Run through worship rehearsal.
- Operate equipment during the night to ensure clear audio and visual quality.
- Troubleshoot and resolve any technical issues that arise during the night.
- Pack down and store equipment at the end of the night.
- If you are unwell, contact team leader.

TRAINING AND SUPPORT:

Training and feedback are provided throughout the night and can be ongoing across multiple weeks.
